COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Saturate Year 1

Saturated Leadership

Whether you look in Hollywood or in a local high school, you will find people, no matter what age, that have no self-control, discipline or excellence in their lives! The World is screaming for our students to become apathetic and undisciplined. We believe that teens who truly change the World are teens who thrive in excellence and discipline. In this class, interns will learn about influence, standards, priorities, accountability, unconditional-love, sustaining your influence, and wisdom.

Old & New Testament Survey

One of Saturate's key goals is to develop within the interns a knowledge and an understanding of the Bible. In this class, interns will take an in-depth look at the Old and New Testaments. Students will learn basic information about the Bible including the authors, main themes, perspectives for each book.

Saturate Year 2

Living a Life of Integrity

As young ministry leaders, it's important that interns be taught how to live a life of integrity. In this class, students will study the Biblical principles that Daniel lived out in his life. God has called all of us to be stand up people in a bow down world. This class takes an in-depth look at the 12 chapters of the book of Daniel in order to learn lessons that will last a life time! Just to name a few, interns will learn about integrity, prayer, and eschatology.

The Life of Christ

Throughout the years of high school, two of the primary concerns of students' lives are to figure out a) who they are, and b) what to do with their lives. We believe there is no better example to pattern our life after than Jesus Christ himself! In this class, students will be challenged to create a life that follows the example Christ left for us as He walked this Earth. Students will learn vital lessons from Christ's birth, life, death, resurrection and reign in this class.

Saturate Year 3

Living a Life of Freedom

Before students go off into their young adult lives, we want to make sure they're equipped with all of the tools necessary to complete the call of God on their lives found in Galatians 5:1, which is to be and stay free! In this class, students will learn about breaking free from any hindrances that would keep them from living the life that God has intended for them. This class takes an in-depth look at the passages found in Isaiah proclaiming Christ's people, and then teaches them how to strategically stay free daily.

Christianity vs Worldly Views

It is said that 50% of first year college students who were raised in a Christian home leave behind the beliefs that they were raised believing. The reasoning behind it is thought to be because of the many world views that come and confuse them. In this class, we want to make sure Saturate students understand why they are Christians and how the Christian worldview is the only thought process that offers hope and can deliver on its promises. Students will learn how to defend themselves against world views such as: secularism, humanism, pragmatism, relativism and others so that they will be able to take a stand for their beliefs once in college or on their own.

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Electives

Students may choose one of the following six classes. We encourage interns to pick a class based on their strongest personal need, and not on what their friends are choosing. The electives that interns may choose between are as follows:

Battlefield of the Mind for Teens

Do you have a hard time controlling your thoughts? Do you have an addiction to something you'd really like to break, but you don't know how or where to start? Do you wish you could win the war that is raging inside of you? Do you wish you knew how to counsel your friends who have an eating disorder, substance addiction, or who has little confidence? If so, this is the class for you. This class is divided into girls-only and guys-only classes, and is set up in a small group discussion format.

Justice Inside and Out

Do you find yourself feeling sorry for people who are less fortunate than you? When you hear of people being abused does it really anger you? Have you ever wondered why God would let such bad things happen, and what you can do to fight back? If so, this class is for you. This class is made up of both guys and girls, and is taught with video and book curriculum.

Dealing with Divorce

If you've watched your parents get divorced, you know how much it stinks. A lot of times there's blame, anger, frustration, confusion, fear, and a ton of other emotions and issues that come up—just as much for you as for your parents. But you don't have to hold on to those emotions anymore. In this class, you can begin healing from the hurt you experienced when your parents split up—whether it happened recently or when you were younger. You'll have a chance to hear stories of other people's experiences with divorce, look at what the Bible says about family and marriage, as well as anger, guilt, and forgiveness, and explore what you're feeling in the midst of it all. In the end, you'll begin to heal as you find some hope for the future.

Everything Female

In this girls-only class, students will learn God's perspective on everything females deal with—everything from body image, purity, friendships, parents, boys, dreams to even self-defense!

Everything Male

In this guys-only class, students will learn God's perspective on everything males deal with—everything from leadership, girls, integrity, temptations, parents, friendships to even dreams and achievements!

Called

Have you ever thought that maybe God has called you into "full time" ministry? Have you ever heard someone say that and wondered what they meant by it? Do you think you'd ever want to serve God through a local church as your full-time career? If so, this class is for you. Students will learn what it means to be called into full-time ministry and about all of the things that go along with that call. Topics like armor bearing, shepherding and serving people, conflict-resolution, creativity in ministry, money management and evangelism will be explored.

Lunch & Snacks

Jason's Deli will be ordered & delivered for students on Tuesdays for students who bring money, and Papa Johns Pizza will be ordered on Thursdays for students who bring money. All students may bring their own lunch. There is a kitchen with a refrigerator and microwave in the Annex. There is also a drink machine in the Annex for students to purchase drinks during their breaks.

Class Work

Each class will have an individualized syllabus, which will be given during Retreat. Each teacher will have his/her own schedule and grading policy. As a whole, all homework assignments, projects, quizzes, tests and reading assignments are crucial to student's full comprehension of the class material. However, we understand the summer is a time to take a break from homework so we will be sensitive to not overload our interns. **Interns will have no more than one homework assignment and one quiz per week and only one project for the entire summer.** It is important that students take each assignment seriously, and work as hard as they can to complete and turn in each assignment on time.

Program Graduation Requirements

In order to promote excellence, all students must finish the program with at least a C average in order to receive a diploma.

To start the summer off right, all interns (both part-time and full-time) are required to attend the retreat during the weekend of May 22nd-24th. Interns will love this laid-back retreat as they spend time playing, resting from the school year, and begin fueling their hearts with God. This will help them get ready for all God is going to do in their lives this summer!

Full-Time Student Status Attendance

We are very understanding of summer vacations, holidays, and other family time that may take place in the summer time. However, we can't urge enough how important it is that students participate in all scheduled class days in order to receive the maximum benefit of the program.

So that we can ensure all students are treated fairly we have the following attendance policy that all students must adhere to:

- All full-time students will be allowed 3 days of personal time off (1 week of class) that they may use at their discretion.
- Any assignments missed during the time off must be made up and turned in no longer than one (1) class day after the scheduled due date.
- If a student misses more than 3 excused days of class, 5 points will be taken off their average grade per day they are absent.

Part-Time Student Status Attendance

We strongly suggest that, if possible, you participate as a Full-Time Intern. With only 6 full weeks of class time, one week of personal time off, and three days (an additional week) of holidays in the summer, any person who lives in town and does not travel for more than 3 weeks at a time is able to enroll as a Full-Time Intern. However, there may be certain circumstances that will not allow a student to participate in Saturate as a full-time intern. Therefore, in order to allow as many students to participate as possible, we offer a part-time intern status for students with these extenuating circumstances.

As a part-time intern, students are allowed to participate one day per week. Students may choose which day of the week they'd like to attend each week, and it may be different each week. Part-time students must be marked present at least 6 times (from 8am-5pm) during the summer to graduate to the following year. Part-time students will not receive grades and will not be required to do homework or take final exams, but may if they prefer. If they do choose to participate in homework, textbooks must be purchased separately.

Program Policies

Dress Code

- Students may **not** wear shorts or skirts to class due to being in the offices during business hours. Shorts may be brought and changed into for outreach hours. Students who bring excessively short shorts will not be allowed to wear them. We suggest you wear Capri pants, khakis or jeans.
- Students must wear their provided Saturate t-shirt or another HPC t-shirt everyday to class. This is to ensure maximum safety for the students so that each intern is easily identifiable in the office areas and around campus.

Intern Dating Policy

Students are not allowed to begin any new dating relationships during the program. If a student is in a relationship prior to the start of Saturate, they must agree to meet with their accountability pastor (who will be assigned to them at the beginning of the summer) one time per week. Also, if both parties of the dating relationship are enrolled in Saturate they are not permitted to sit by each other anytime during intern hours, and all public displays of affection should be withheld. All such actions will be disciplined.

Intern Guest Policy

Any intern who would like to bring a guest to Saturate during class hours must obtain prior approval from the director at least one week in advance.

Intern Driving Policy

Interns are allowed to drive to and from class; however, we do not allow interns to use their cars during Tuesdays and Thursdays unless it is pre-authorized by the director. Interns will not be allowed to take their cars to the outreaches or to any other place during class hours of 8am-5pm.

Interns will be allowed to drive to the Highland Campus from the ITI College on Sunday mornings.
